



# Junior School Fee Schedule 2022

The following schedule of fees has been approved by the College Council, effective from the commencement of Term 1, 2022. The College reviews the fee schedule on an annual basis.

**Services** \$450 per term

This is a compulsory charge per student for general services, improvements to facilities and technology.

## Lunches – Optional for Day Students (no morning tea)

\$420 per term

Day students have the option of purchasing lunches provided by the College dining hall every school day or bringing their own lunch. A form requesting to 'opt in' for lunches will be emailed at the commencement at each school year.

## Family Concession

The College grants a tuition fee concession to siblings attending the College from Kindergarten to Year 12 simultaneously:

Eldest student in family	Full Fee
1st Sibling	10%
2nd Sibling	20%
3rd and subsequent Siblings	30%

## After School Care (K-6)

After School Care will be available on request from 3:15 pm – 6:00 pm. There is a flat charge of \$15 per child or \$20 per family per day. Penalty fees will be incurred at the rate of \$10 for every fifteen (15) minutes after that time. After School Care placements will be at the discretion of the College and will be allocated on a needs basis.

## New Students

Once an Application for Enrolment has been received by the College, applicants will usually be interviewed. Following a successful interview, an Offer of Enrolment will then be made. The enrolment will be finalised on receipt of the signed Offer of Enrolment, the enrolment fee and a number of completed forms.

## Students Continuing from Preparatory School to Kindergarten

For a student continuing from Preparatory to Kindergarten, an Offer of Enrolment will be made. Enrolment can be finalised by paying \$450 (being the difference between the Preparatory and Junior School enrolment fees) and returning the signed offer.

## Fee Statement

A fee statement is issued prior to the commencement of each school term and is due for payment on the first day of term. This account includes tuition, lunches as appropriate, disbursements and services. A second fee statement is issued mid-term reflecting any further disbursements and outstanding balance from previous accounts. The College may refuse re-entry of a student if any fees are outstanding. An administration charge of 3% of the outstanding balance is applied to accounts not paid by the due date.

## Notice of Withdrawal

One terms notice in writing or one terms fees are required in lieu of notice given before the withdrawal of a student except in the graduating term for Higher School Certificate students. This notice is also required in the case of boarders becoming day students.

## Payment of Fees in Advance

A \$50 discount is applicable to the fees if paid on the first day of term.

An allowance is available to those who wish to pay the full yearly fee by the first day of Term 1. Please contact the Accounts Team on 02 6331 3911 to take advantage of this offer.

## Other Charges

Additional charges will apply for extra programs taken, including incursions, excursions and other incidentals.

- Uniforms are to be paid for in full at the time of purchase (online or at the Uniform Shop) located at the Junior School Campus. Eftpos facilities are available.
- Text books and stationery are not included in tuition fees.
